

LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT AWARD

The Leadership Development Award recognizes an adult troop/group leader who participates in training that increases her/his skills in delivering the Girl Scout Program to girls.

Basic Criteria

1. Must be a registered Girl Scout adult.
2. Must have completed at least one year as a troop/group leader or assistant leader.
3. Orientation and Leadership Essentials completed
4. Attendance in at least two Council or Service Unit meetings or events.
5. A certified First Aider and a Troop Camp trained Volunteer is recruited and trained. Troop Camp training includes Overnight Adventures, Outdoor Skills I & II.

Approval: A Leadership Development Pin Application Form must be completed and submitted to Adult Development Manager for verification and approval.

Leadership Development Pin: The pin is earned by completing the basic criteria. The pin is worn on either side of the Years of Service pin. Additional training is recognized by leaves.

Additional Recognitions:

Green Leaf: Represents ten accumulated hours of training or one CEU.* Five green leaves are replaced by one silver leaf.

Silver Leaf: Represents 50 accumulated hours of training or five CEUs.* Five silver leaves are replaced by one gold leaf.

Gold Leaf: Represents 250 accumulated hours of training or 25 CEUs.*¹

Be a role model for your Girl Scouts and wear your Leadership Development Pin!

* CEU is defined as ten hours of participation in a recognized continuing education program, with qualified instruction and sponsorship.
