STEP 4

Girls develop an understanding of sustainability by talking together about how solutions can be lasting.

STEP 3
Define your Take Action Project

- Be part of a Troop or group where girls take the lead
- Take action on a community issue the Troop or group care about that they would like to improve within their Girl Scout or local Community
- Choose a project that puts the Promise and Law into action

STEP 2
Complete a Junior level Journeys
Choose from either *Agent of Change* or *Get Moving*

STEP 1
Attend a council sponsored Bronze Workshop (this step is *recommended*, but is *not required*)

Return a completed Final Report and Time log for each Girl Scout to GSCSNJ/Newfield or any council shop to release pins.

The Girl Scout Bronze Award Troop service project can be done in or outside of Girl Scouting.

The Girl Scout Bronze Award is the highest award a Junior Girl Scout can earn. To receive the award, each girl or Troop should complete a project that shows each Girl Scout understands and lives by the Girl Scout Law.
