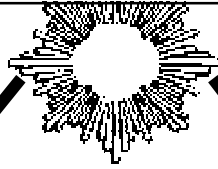


JOURNEYS: THE GIRL SCOUT SILVER AWARD



All steps must be completed by Sept. 30 after the completion of 8th grade.

STEP 8-Share/Reflect

Tell your story / Share / Reflect
Submit FINAL REPORT & Time Log

STEP 7 - Take Action

- Lead your team and carry out your plan
- Use the tools you have developed / check Journeys for tips.
- Hit a speed bump? Learn from it and adjust your plan →

Any changes or amendments to your approved project must be resubmitted to GSCSNJ for prior approval.

STEP 6 - Present your Plan

- Fill out your Project Planning checklist
- What steps do we need to take to reach our goal?
- What special talents can each girl use to make the project a success?
- Groups & Organizations / Others / Supplies / Realistic timeline?
- Once your project is approved, refer back to your Plan (Step 5)

• Submit your Girl Scout Silver Award Proposal to GSCSNJ for pre approval.
(Your project must be approved before you begin Step 7.)

STEP 5 - Creating your PLAN

- Choose a project based on what matters most to you and where you can create some positive change.
- Consider sustainability of your project * Review your issues chart, community map and notes.
- Create a plan that outlines the best use of your time and talents, making the most with what you have, that's your challenge. Remember you can always go back to your Journey for project ideas!

STEP 2 Identify your Issue

- To solve any problem, you must first identify it!
- Start by asking yourself what matters most to you?

STEPS 3 & 4 - Team Building / Exploration

- 2 Models / Small Team or Solo / You decide!
- Invite others to join your team to support your efforts. Reach out to Friends, teachers, business owners and experts from various organizations.

STEP 1 FRAMEWORK

- Attend a Council sponsored Silver & GOLD Workshop
- Complete level appropriate Journeys then Identify your Issue

Remember that the focus of the project SHOULD be outside of the Girl Scout Community!
